Children's Ministry provides many opportunities for your child to learn and grow. Every Sunday in each age group our volunteers and staff make sure that all children hear a Bible story and are prayed for.

## Sunday Morning at 9:00 a.m.

**Nursery (infant through two-year-old)** We provide a clean, safe, and loving environment for nursery-age children. Parents are welcome to observe or participate with their child upon request. Our three-minute rule means no child is allowed to cry or remain in distress for more than three minutes.

**Preschool (potty-trained from age three through five-year-old pre-kindergarten)** All of the groups have age-appropriate playtime, Bible story, and creative craft time.

**Elementary (kindergarten through 5th grade)** We require parents/guardians to accompany their child to check-in and pick their child up at check-out time. At 9:00 a.m. we provide age-appropriate Sunday school time.
