### Icebreaker Question:

- 1 | If you had a time machine that would work only once, what point in the future or in history would you visit?

### Into the Text Questions:

#### Read Matthew 28:16-20

- 1 | What is the context for these verses? What is Jesus asking the disciples to do? Who is Jesus speaking to? What type of relationship have they had with Jesus up to this point? What promise does the Great Commission end with? What implications does this have for us as we share the gospel? What implications does this have for our daily lives?
- 2 | If Jesus is not physically with us, how does He uphold His promise to always be with us in the present age? What are some examples of the Holy Spirit's work through the rest of the New Testament? How is the Holy Spirit our Helper, as Jesus said He would be?
- 3 | Read John 16:8 and Matthew 10:19. How does the Holy Spirit give us God's presence when we share the gospel? Read John 20:22. How was the promise of John 14:6 fulfilled in this verse? What affect did the Holy Spirit have on the early disciples' witness?

### Application Questions:

- 1 | We can always be more prepared, but sometimes the idea of needing to know more stops us from engaging. Jesus is commanding us to get in the game – right now. So, the question is: For you to live out the Great commission every day, everywhere you go, what changes or commitments do you need to make? What would this look like lived out?
- 2 | What is the relationship between worship of God and witness for God? How is our witness for God a demonstration of our belief in the worthiness of God to be worshipped by all people? What are some excuses that we make for not making disciples? What do these excuses reveal about us? What do they reveal about our view of discipleship?
