- 1. Observations of SYMPTOMS
- 2. Diagnosis of DISEASE
- 3. Prognosis of CURE
- 4. Prescription for TREATMENT

### Four Steps of a Social/Spiritual Analysis

- 1. The PROBLEM (Undesired Effect)
- 2. The CAUSE of the PROBLEM (The Undesired Cause)
- 3. The SOLUTION (The Desired Effect)
- 4. The CAUSE of the SOLUTION (The Desired Cause)

### Typical Non-Christian View of Life's Issues

- 1. The PROBLEM VICES
- 2. The CAUSE of the PROBLEM IGNORANCE
- 3.The SOLUTION VIRTUES
- 4.The CAUSE of the SOLUTION KNOWLEDGE

#### The Christian View of Life's Issues




- 1. The PROBLEM SPIRITUAL DISEASE (Death)
- 2. The CAUSE of the PROBLEM SIN (Sinful Nature)

#### The Christian View of Life's Issues



- 3. The SOLUTION SALVATION (Restored relationship with our Creator God)
- 4. The CAUSE of the SOLUTION FAITH in the WORK OF CHRIST (Redemption/Justification)



Good Character is not the Answer to the Problem of life, it is the result (or consequence) that comes after the Solution is caused (happens). Christian Character flows out of faith in Christ.

# 3. Remember the Danger of Moralism


Judging others and distorting our own sense of importance (or spirituality)

Who am I? They mock me, these lonely questions of mine.


