

### The Four Types of Gifts

#### 4. The Liberal Gift (cont.)

- \* Generous people are liberated from the trap of selfishness
- \* Generous people recognize that there are greater ends in human life.
- \* Generous people discover the joy of giving.
- \* Generous giving normalizes the act of giving within a community of faith.
- \* Generosity should be an act of worship to the giving of all good gifts.

"The model of liberal giving aims at more than satisfying the immediate needs of the needy. It aims at more than making the needy self-sufficient, thereby ending their reliance on philanthropy. Above all, it aims, in the course of meeting and preventing needs, to turn recipients into givers, people who concern ourselves more with what we can share with others than with what other can give to us.

This approach moves philanthropy from social control to cultivation of character. It ceases to equate giving with transfers of wealth. In essence, the liberal model of giving cultivates and celebrates the giving potential of every human being."
