STUDY

Main Topics: Comfort, Obedience,

Read Acts 9:10-19

- What precedent does Ananias set for us through his response to God?
- What did Ananias have to fight against in order to obey God's command?
- Where does Scripture show that it is difficult to grow where it is comfortable?
- Cameron said God does not see people the same way we see them (v.15). How does this change our attitude towards others?
- Cameron said, "God turns enemies into family." How does this lie at the very heart of the Gospel?
- Why does the comfort of God supersede the comfort of man?

APPLY

- Ask yourself, what is your typical response when God convicts or prompts you to do something?
- When have you tried to resist obeying a command that God has shown you?
- What fears do you typically encounter when God asks you to step out of your comfort zone?
 - How can you combat those fears?
- Have you ever seen God save someone you thought would never give their life to Christ?
- Since God goes to great lengths to turn enemies into family, how can you seek to do this through your life?
- When have you struggled with the comfort of isolation?
- **How is God convicting you to step out of your comfort zone this year?**
 - As a group how can we help you pursue this?
