- Is there a name of God that has special meaning to you?
- How can God's many names enhance our worship?

- What does it look like for God to be "El Adonai" according to Scripture? (Matthew 6:24)
- What are some of the reasons we should pray using God's different names?

## APPLY

- Did you figure out what your name means?
- Where else in life do we use multiple names for people and what does this allow us to do?
- Have you found value in understanding and using the different names of God?
- Were you comforted or challenged by any of the names of God we studied?
