VISION

- **Forgive** Ephesians 4:32 – Because Christ forgave our astronomical debt of sin, we commit to surrender our need for revenge or bitterness and freely forgive one another for sins committed against us.
- **Pray** James 5:16 – Because we believe God has greater power than any of us, we commit to pray for one another, asking God to sanctify, strengthen, heal, convict, and protect each other.
- **Show Hospitality** 1 Peter 4:9 – Because God has shown us incomparable hospitality by welcoming us into His family, we commit to welcome one another into our lives, our homes, and our families.
- **Confess** James 5:16 – Because God calls us to live in the light, we commit to regularly confess our sins to one another in order to foster true repentance and loving accountability.
- **Serve** 1 Peter 4:10 – Because Christ set the chief example for us by serving sinners, we commit to sacrificially serve one another through considering and prioritizing the needs of others.
- **Teach & Admonish** Colossians 3:16 – Because Christ has called us to obey all He has commanded, we commit to lovingly and faithfully teach one another God's Word.
- **Bear One Another's Burdens** Galatians 6:2 – Because Christ describes the church as a body that is interconnected by every piece, we commit to help one another through strongholds of sin, financial difficulties, and life's trials.
- **Comfort** 2 Corinthians 13:11 – Because of the incredible comfort Christ has brought us through His Spirit, we commit to comfort one another amidst loss, doubt, depression, and anxiety.
- **Submit** Ephesians 5:21 – Because Christ submitted to the will of God the Father, we commit to submit to one another out of love and reverence for our Savior.
