Jesus Calls the Disciples

(Matthew 4:18-22, 9:9-13, 10:2-4)

Week 1

Brite Idea: Jesus calls us to be resilient disciples.

He Question: Why is Jesus worthy of being followed?

Week 2

Brite Idea: Jesus teaches us how to pray.

Week 3

He Question: Why did God give us the Bible?

We Question: Is reading the Bible really important?
