Read Colossians 4:2-6

2. Why do you think prayer is so important for spreading the gospel?
3. What does it mean to "make the most of every opportunity," and how can we do that with friends or classmates?
4. This passage talks about praying for chances to share our faith. What does it say we should ask for when we pray?
5. How does this passage encourage us to pray for wisdom when sharing our faith?
6. Why is it important to speak wisely when we're sharing the gospel?
7. How can we prepare to answer people's questions about our faith in a way that is both respectful and honest?
8. Why is it important to adapt how we share the gospel depending on who we're talking to?
9. What does it mean to let our words be "seasoned with salt," and how could that make our message more meaningful?
10. Why should we avoid being argumentative when we share the gospel?
11. Why shouldn't we feel embarrassed or ashamed when we talk about the gospel?
12. What are some things that could distract from our message when we share the gospel?
13. How does this passage encourage you to get involved in sharing the gospel?
14. What does it mean to be "devoted to prayer," and how could that look in your life?
15. How does this passage challenge you to share your faith in a more thoughtful and loving way?
