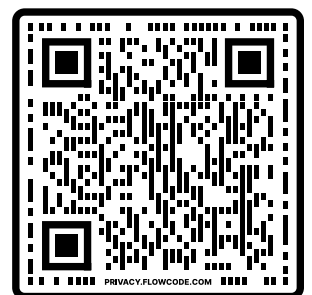

THE PROCESS TO JOIN

Joining the Worship Ministry at Boca Raton Community Church is a thoughtful process designed to help ensure that every team member is spiritually prepared, relationally connected, and equipped to serve effectively. Below is the step by step process to join the worship team.

Step 1: Online Application



Complete the online application by providing your personal information, sharing your salvation testimony, completing spiritual gifts and experience questionnaire, and submitting a vocal or instrumental audition video. *If a Worship Interest Meeting is scheduled before your audition, please sign up and come to learn more about the process and our ministry.*

Step 2: In-Person Audition



Qualified applicants will be invited to an in-person audition, where we'll evaluate musical skill and competency, explore your personal calling and ministry fit, and get to know you and your story. Following the audition, you'll be invited to attend a worship rehearsal to experience what it's like to serve on the Boca Community Worship Ministry team. *If you're interested in serving on the Production Team, one of our directors will contact you with the next steps.*

Step 3: Handbook & Covenant



If proceeding, you will receive a Worship Ministry Handbook and Covenant for your review. *All potential applicants must read, pray, understand, and sign the document to be considered.*

Step 4: Security



Once your Handbook and Covenant has been completed and returned, *you will be asked to submit a background check and learn the campus security requirements.*

Step 5: Welcome Email



Upon acceptance by the Worship Director and team, you will receive a **Welcome Email**, which officially begins your onboarding process as a worship team member. The email will include instructions for setting up your Planning Center Online account (our scheduling database), scheduling your shadowing times, and scheduling a time to have your headshot taken. *Once these steps are complete, you will receive key-card access to designated rehearsal and service areas, when applicable.*

Step 6: Shadow Experience



New team members will be asked to attend at least *two Wednesday night rehearsals* and *two Sunday morning run-throughs/services*, where they will be paired with an experienced team member to guide them through the shadow experience. During this time, you will observe our culture and expectations, learn rehearsal procedures, understand service preparation, and become comfortable before actively serving. We want every team member to feel confident, prepared, and supported before stepping into a leadership role.

Step 7: Scheduling & Rotation



Once all steps have been completed, you will be added to our regular serving rotation. Our goal is to schedule volunteers weeks, and often months in advance whenever possible. *Team members are encouraged to submit Planning Center blackout dates well in advance, accept or decline serving requests promptly, and communicate conflicts as early as possible.*

Step 8: Community & Ongoing Growth



Serving on the worship team is more than having a part to play—it's joining a family and having a place to belong. As a team member, you will be invited to participate in Team Nights, Nights of Worship, training events, and leadership development and discipleship opportunities. We desire every team member to grow spiritually, build meaningful relationships, and flourish in their calling as they serve the local church. Our Team Nights are gatherings for all worship and production team members and their families, and an RSVP link will be sent to you about a month before each Team Night. *As you serve, we encourage you to be intentionally involved in our church community by participating in the life of the church in a variety of ways.*
